We offer eleven rentals made up of 7 lakeside cabins from 1 to 3 bedrooms, and 4 vacation rental homes: the 4/2 LodgeHome 8, the 3+/2 FarmHouse 9, the 3+/3 LakeHome 10 and the 4/3 LogHome 11.

- Cabins 7 and vacation rentals 8, 9, 10 and 11 have clothes washer/dryer
- Cabins 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and 11 have air-conditioning
- One sleeper sofa or futon per cabin, two in cabins 4, 9 & 10
- Water's Edge or Lakeview porches/decks on all cabins except 8 & 9 which have private yards, hammocks and decks but are a short walk to the lake.
- Gas fireplaces in every rental
- Picnic table and BBQ grill (charcoal), gas grills in 9, 10 and 11
- Row boat or dockage for your own boat (rental motors & pontoon boats) available)
- Free use: Kayaks, Canoes, Stand Up Paddle Boards and Pedal Boats, also bicycles & Helmets, volleyball, basketball & horseshoes
- Within easy walking distance to some great hike & bike trails... go for a mile or miles!

Accommodations Include

Your first pot of custom Cedaroma blend coffee, basic kitchenware, salt & pepper, charcoal grill, dish soap, toilet tissue, shampoo & conditioner, hand soap, garbage bags, one set of kitchen towels, waste basket liners and one set of bath towels per registered guest. Early May to Mid October, rentals include one row boat OR dockage for your own boat.

Bicycles, Basketball, Volleyball & Horseshoes

These are free amenities of the resort and you are welcome to use them anytime you like, first come first served. The sanitizer can has a spray solution for bicycle helmets. The Basket/Volley balls are in the blue covered container near the basketball court, the horseshoes are at the horseshoe pit and the bicycles are at the back of the big garages. The St. Germain Bicycle Trail starts at the corner of South Bay Road on the South side of highway 70, just two houses East of us. PLEASE return bicycles to the rack area at the end of every day so others may also enjoy them. Wipe the handlebars down with sanitizer after use please.

Boat & Motor Rentals

If you have reserved a motor for a fishing boat or one of the pontoons for your stay it will be ready for you on the day you arrive. All boats must be checked out with a Cedaroma Team Member. Marine rentals require a \$100 damages security deposit. Deposits will be refunded online at the conclusion of a successful boat check-in, less gas used, small damages, and return of keys and anchors.

Please call 715-479-1040 to schedule your boat return. Deposits are refunded directly from our bank to yours. You will receive an email with instructions on initiating the transfer. The keyword unique to you is your reservation number. You are responsible for all boat/motor damages, the deposit may not cover all costs and additional charges may occur. Failure to check your boat back in with Lynn before departing the resort tells us you are forfeiting your deposit.

Check In

Standard check in time for Fall & Winter 2020 and Spring 2021 is 3pm, Summer 2021 is 5pm. We developed a self check-in process for this year. Your check-in documents will be on your kitchen table in the cabin. Sign and place in the lockbox (looks like a mailbox) on the left side of the office door by the end of the day on arrival day. I am always available for questions, but this guide should provide you most of the information you need for a marvelous contactless vacation.

Check Out NEW & Important

We are putting as big a spread of time as possible between guests. Please see your confirmation letter for your specific check in/check out times.

Check out tasks: Guest list

- 1. Open windows 6 inches, if raining or likely to rain, open just 1 inch
- 2. Fill and start the dishwasher with as many plates, cups, glasses and utensils you can fit. It doesn't matter if they are already clean, we want to know they are also sanitized.
- 3. Drop used towels in the shower
- 4. Strip beds, put sheets & pillow cases in the shower also
- 5. Quilts, shams and blankets can stay on the bed. They will be changed out, but have a different process they go through than the linens.
- 6. Take your trash up to the dumpsters on your way out.

Classes Yoga, SUP & SUP Yoga:

June through September we offer weekly Yoga and Stand Up Paddle Yoga classes. You are invited to participate and get a 10% discount as a resort guest when you pre-register. You can find a schedule of class options online www.YogaPaddler.com.

Credit Cards

While a credit card does need to be on file to reserve and hold your cabin, we prefer a check, cash or ACH transfer for the outstanding balance. Payments by credit card other than the initial \$100 deposit will incur a 3.5% processing fee.

Cribs & High Chairs

Available on a first come first served basis for no fee.

Fire Pit

The resort has one shared fire pit located to the east of Cabin 4. Anyone can start the fire in the evening and everyone is welcome to join in the festivities (Please maintain social distancing.) Be mindful that other families may also want to use the fire pit. Dry paper is inside the fish house and free firewood between the trees outside the fish house and at each of the vacation rental homes. NEVER leave the fire pit unattended. If you are last person at the pit on any particular evening, drop a bucket of water on the coals and cover the pit with the BBQ top we have for that purpose. Be fire safe.

Fish Cleaning House

This is the screened room to the south and east of Cabin 4. Here you will find running water, lights, a good cleaning board, cleansers and sanitizers. Put a couple sheets of newspaper on the cleaning board, clean the fish on the newspaper, wrap the guts then bundle the package into one of the small plastic bags provided. Tie the bundle tightly and drop into the freezer we provide to control the smell. Let us know if you think the fish house might need attention.

Fishing Boats and Docking Your Boat

If you haven't brought a boat with you nor rented one with a motor from us, you can claim any of the rowboats found at the docks or on shore without motors on them. You are welcome to put your own motor on a rowboat. Please see Lynn for docking instructions for your boat. In the summer there is no motorized docking at the U-shaped dock. This is a people dock and needs to stay open and available for swimming, fishing and just sitting around relaxing. Once you have been assigned dock space, please keep the same location for the duration of your visit

Grills

Each cabin comes with it's own charcoal BBQ grill. Grills are cleaned prior to your visit, but not during. Please dispose of your used charcoal in the fire pit especially since it is likely still warm. Vacation Rental Houses 8, 9, 10 and 11 have gas grills.

Paddle outings

Mondays at 1 pm I lead a public paddle outing on local waterways. Guests are welcome to join at a cost of \$25 per paddle board when we are exploring new waters. Please RSVP by Sunday evening so I can plan my van with enough boards. I can also arrange private outings with at least 6 people, kayak or Stand Up Paddle Board. Please plan in advance.

<u>Parking</u>

Each cabin has two parking places. If you are trailering, there is additional trailer space next to Cabin 7. If all these spaces are taken, I can help you find a place for your trailer give me a call, 715-479-1040.

<u>Protecting your valuables</u>

No cabin is completely burglar proof and we suggest that you do not leave valuables in your cabins. We cannot assume responsibility for stolen articles.

Recycling:

Each cabin has a green waste basket and a blue recycling basket. When dumping, the garbage bin on the left is for recycled products and the bigger one on the right is regular trash. Reservations for 2021

With a \$100 deposit we can confirm your 2021 visit. **NOTE**: Weekly-stay guests have first right of renewal on a cabin for the following season and indicate interest by leaving a \$100 deposit prior to departure. That deposit secures your cabin until 12/1/2020, at which point the remainder of the 25% deposit is due. If you cancel prior to the 12/1 due date, the full \$100 deposit is refunded. If cancelling after 12/1 the \$100 deposit is forfeit. We would love to have you back!

New for reservations arriving after May 1, 2021: Guests will be prepaid for their summer vacation 30 days prior to arrival. Payment options include via mail in check, an online ACH Transfer (Venmo) or credit card (with a fee)



Sanitizer stations (removed in winter)

We have located 4 foam hand sanitizer dispensers around the resort:

On the beach wall in front of Cabin 2

On the lake facing wall of the storage closest, next to the fish house

On the bench across from the volleyball/basket ball court

At the office front door

We have put sanitizer and paper towels on the u-shaped dock, kayak/fire pit area, basketball court and at the bicycles. Please sanitize chairs, paddles, vessels, balls, horseshoes and bicycle handle bars & seats after use.

Social Distancing

Safe-in-Place at our place. We take this to heart. Please be mindful of others and keep an appropriate distances when in public spaces. Be aware that others might also want to be on the big U-shaped dock or at the fire pit. Share and distance. Together we can make it work for everyone. If you think we need to intervene on a situation, please let us know. We would far rather us negotiate the few vacation challenges that can come up than to have guests get frustrated trying to work a situation out themselves.

Swimming Beach

Swim at your own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty. Children are the responsibility of their parents and must be accompanied by an adult.

SUP (Stand Up Paddle Boards) Canoes, Kayaks and Pedal Boats

These are found to the East of Cabin 4 and in front of Cabin 3. Please return them when you are done so others may share in the pleasure of paddling & pedaling. Vessels need to drain over night. Return them upside down and in the racks. We guarantee 4 kayaks, 6 SUP boards and 2 canoes available for resort quests shared use, though there are generally many more than this. Please sanitize paddles and touch regions of the vessels after use. Additional SUP boards can be rented on a daily or weekly basis. See www.YogaPaddler.com for details.

Pet Policy

We love our dog and enjoy meeting those of our guests. It is important with a shared space resort to have policies in place that assure that all guests, those with and without pets, are having the best vacation possible. No pet is allowed to disturb the experience of another guest. So here are the basics:

Traveling with Pets

- For the comfort and safety of our summer guests: there are no pets allowed in cabins 1-5 and 7 during peak summer weeks.
- During non-peak dates, we do allow pets all cabins. Cabins 6, 8, 9, 10 and 11 allow pets year round.
- Pets are not allowed in the beach area between cabins 1 & 4, but are welcome to swim east of Cabin 4 beyond the **h** dock.
- Unannounced pets could be refused accommodation.
- We are glad to supply bags for you to clean up after your dog. We are not glad if we have to clean up after your dog.
- Pets are defined as dogs, cats and birds with a maximum 2 pets per cabin/ house.
- Unless in the lake, your dogs must be on leash at all times when in public areas including the resort cabins 1-7 and the basketball area. Pets may swim and boat without a leash, but you need to have them under voice command. Some of our neighbors are sensitive that Cedaroma visiting pets stay on Cedaroma property.
- For the comfort of all guests please ensure that your pet does not disturb the vacation experience of other guests. This includes barking and unwelcome approaches. I do keep notes of barking dogs. They are not welcome back.

The pet owner accepts full responsibility for and liability arising from the pet (including but not limited to: property damage to the resort or personal injury to guests, associates or 3rd party). If you yours is a muddy, fun loving pet, we have throws for the furniture, just ask us.

We want to successfully have you bring your pet and enjoy Cedaroma with your family. It is important to respect the space of others and their vacation quality. Be polite and sensitive to your surroundings and fellow resort guests. Be certain that you and your pet are a good fit for a shared-space vacation such as a resort offers. If your pet is causing a disturbance, we can ask that the pet be removed from the resort.

Safe-in-Place at our Place

Here at Cedaroma Lodge it is our goal to offer guests a safer vacation environment so they may continue family traditions and build Northwoods memories. I can't think of a better place to socially distance than Cedaroma Lodge. Below is a list of changes we are currently implementing for this summer. This list is subject to change as we get new information.

- Cleanliness is First! Always. We first rid the cabins of dirt and germs, then sanitize. We have prided ourselves on our clean cabins for years and you've noticed and commented. Thank you! This year we have researched and discovered new products and changed some of our housekeeping jobs around to best meet the needs with efficiency.
- Sanitizing of Dishes, Cups and Silverware: All cabins have dishwashers this summer. Washing dishes by hand is no longer good enough.
- Blankets & Quilts: We have purchased a second set of blankets and quilts for each bed and will be sanitizing them between guests. Please consider bringing your own pillows for this visit.
- Additional Time Between Guest Arrival and Departure: in order to provide a safer environment for all of our guests, the Cedaroma Team and our families, the schedule for summer weekly guests will be arrivals after 5pm on Sunday, departure by midnight Saturday. Saturday all day is yours to enjoy the resort, but plan on leaving sometime after dinner or enjoy a final evening at the fire pit, then head home. We will use the overnight to air out the cabins before our team enters the units the next morning and the next set of guests arrive. This will have been done for your visit, and the next one after you and so on for the whole summer. Yes, we are giving full-rate weekly rentals a credit equal to half a day of your cabin rate. We welcome very few visitors that are not on a weekly basis over the summer, but these too will have an empty night between guest arrivals and will be priced accordingly.

Strategically Placed Sanitizer Stations: we will install covered containers with sanitizer spray and a roll of paper towels in high use areas such as the beach, volleyball court, fire pit, kayak/canoe storage rack and bicycles area. Please sanitize items before and after use. Please do not litter, there are garbage cans at the fire pit, fish cleaning house up at the big garages or in your own cabin. Remember to wash your hands frequently and to social distance from other guests as these two efforts are most effective against the virus.
